

PARENT-COACH AGREEMENT

COACH'S COMMITMENT:

- 1.) I commit to being punctual for all practices and games, and bringing the equipment.
- 2.) I commit to teaching my players to play fairly, and to respect the rules of the game, the officials, and the opponents.
- 2.) I commit to ensuring that the equipment and playing field are safe for my players.
- 3.) I commit to encourage my players to do their best, and to not reprimand them for making mistakes or performing poorly.
- 4.) I commit to coaching them to develop good skills in dribbling, passing, and shooting.
- 5.) I commit to teaching them to have fun while helping them to succeed.

PARENT(S)'S COMMITMENT:

- 1.) I will not force my child to participate in sports.
- 2.) I will remember that my child plays sports for his/her enjoyment, not for mine.
- 3.) I will encourage my child to play by the rules, and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility, profanity, or violence.
- 4.) I will teach my child that doing one's best is as important as winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game/event.
- 5.) I will never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 6.) I will remember that children learn best by example. I will applaud good plays/performance by both my child's team and their opponents.
- 7.) I will never question the official's judgement or honesty in public.
- 8.) I will respect and show appreciation for the volunteer coaches who give their time to provide sport activities for my child. I will not "sideline coach" as I understand this can cause confusion and may be contrary to instructions that the coach has given to the players.
- 9.) I will stay for the duration of each practice/game to encourage my child.
- 10.) I will make my child feel like a winner every time by offering praise for competing fairly and giving his/her best.
